EID tags can be ordered through an animal health supplier by providing your farm's premise ID number. Premise ID numbers can be obtained by filling out an application at www.agri.ohio.gov/divs/animalid/animalid.asp or through your local veterinarian.

ENTRIES

- Deadline: August 16, 2019. Preference is given to earlier entries; late entries may be refused.
- Fee: \$50 per head, non-refundable. Entry fees are payable to: Ohio Shorthorn Breeders Association (mail to Beth Carper, 6371 Giehl Road, Delaware, OH 43015)
- Entries will not be accepted without the entry fee. No exceptions. Faxed or emailed entries are acceptable when followed by payment before August 16, 2019. treasurer@ohioshorthorns.org; fax: 740-524-3180

REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES

- All entries must be registered with the American Shorthorn Association.
- ASA registration certificates **MUST ACCOMPANY** payment unless registration is pending. IF registration is pending, pedigree info must be completed on the entry form.

RULES AND GUIDELINES

- Genetic Defect Testing: Animals that are potential carriers of known genetic defects should be tested prior to entry, but it is not required. Animals found to be carriers of genetic defects will still be permitted to sell.
- Cattle can arrive Friday, September 20, 2019 and all cattle must be in place by Saturday, September 21, 2019 at 5 p.m.
- All cattle must have an official health certificate on or after August 23, 2019 and must include 15-Digit ID Number for each consignment.
- Bedding will be provided. Stall space will be assigned.
- The sale order will be determined by the sale committee. Cattle will be evaluated during check-in and immediately afterwards in the stalls.
- All consignors must be members of the Ohio Shorthorn Breeders Association. Dues will be deducted from sale proceeds if consignors are not members of the organization.
- All sales, including “no sales/buybacks,” will be charged full commission and full sales expense.
- All animals must be tagged with an EID tag. (EID tags can be ordered through an animal health supplier or through your local veterinarian by providing your farm’s premise ID number. Premise ID numbers can be obtained by filling out an application at www.agri.ohio.gov/divs/animalid/animalid.asp)
- All cattle should be in good health. Any cattle deemed to be ill or a potential detriment to healthy cattle will be asked to leave the sale facility by request of the Sale Committee.
